Intent	<p><b>School Vision</b></p> <p><i>"Making a difference today, for tomorrow"</i></p> <p>As a UNCRC Rights Respecting school, Mountjoy's vision is that all students will maximise every moment and opportunity at school, learning skills that will prepare them for life beyond school.</p>	<p><b>Teacher Plans</b></p> <p>Teachers use the appropriate curriculum for the individual pupils in their class and their medium term plans reflect these. Teacher's plans incorporate the interventions recommended by therapists into a pupil's respective curriculum.</p>
Implementation	<p><b>Curriculum management &amp; development</b></p> <p>To meet the needs of all students the school curriculum is made up of the Early Years Foundation and Post-16 curricula and three additional curricula:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Informal – Victoria School MSI</li> <li>Semi-Formal – Equals SLD</li> <li>Formal – differentiated National Curriculum</li> </ul>	<p><b>Teacher delivery</b></p> <p>Delivery of learning via total communication methods to small groups, paired, individual interventions and whole class learning as appropriate.</p> <p>Delivery of learning via regular outdoor learning visits to local settings including: Magdalen Farm, Carymoor Environmental Centre, Weymouth Outdoor Education Centre, Forest &amp; Beach School, Paddle-boarding and surf therapy.</p>
Impact	<p><b>What is learnt in the school</b></p> <p>Students gain qualifications and accreditations in ASDAN, OCR, Duke of Edinburgh Award, John Muir Award, Shakespeare Arts Awards, Mountjoy Awards. Life skills, confidence and transition into adulthood.</p>	<p><b>What is learnt in the classroom</b></p> <p>Curriculum progress            Progress against individual MAP targets            Progress towards therapist's recommendations            Progress towards EHCP outcomes, assessed at annual reviews.</p>
